a) **Turtle and Tortoise**

**b) Turtle and Terrapins**

Turtle: - Turtles are aquatic or semi aquatic creatures.

Terrapins: - They live near the waterbodies they have fresh or slightly salty water.

They have webbed feet with claws.

They eat earthworms, snails, green leafy vegetables, and berries.

**c) Tortoise and Terrapins**

Tortoise: - They spend most of their time on land.

They have stubby feet.

They eat shrubs and grasses

Terrapins: - They live near the waterbodies they have fresh or slightly salty water.

They have webbed feet with claws.

They eat earthworms, snails, green leafy vegetables, and berries.

**d) Fresh Cheese and Soft cheese**

Fresh Cheese: - It contains a lot of moisture; it is soft and simple cheese e.g paneer.

Soft cheese: - It contains less moisture than fresh cheese and in this curd is melted with boiling water and massaged e.g feta cheese.

**e) Firm Cheese and Hard Cheese**

Firm Cheese: - It has less moisture than soft cheese. This is packed in moulds to remove all moisture e.g Cheddar Cheese.

Hard Cheese: -This type of cheese has the least moisture and it is hard. This cheese is left in a cool and dark place for up to 4 -5 years e.g Parmesan Cheese.
